a. Co-curricular Activities: For example

- i. Student symposia/conferences in the relevant disciplines of basic medical sciences and clinical sciences through their five/four year stay in the Medical College and Institute of Dentistry. They may contribute/participate in these symposia and conferences locally or at the national level. (To be partly funded by the College Admn after determining the genuine and legitimate assistance).
- ii. Student Electives at the national of international level as per need and requirement of the students for planning and pursuing their future career objectives. (The students undertaking these electives will manage them throughout their own finances).
- iii. Educational Trips: The students may undertake an educational trip starting from 2nd year onwards for orientation of the different regions of the country to study the local population, their social and medical problems. (The students of different academic years to contribute and manage finances themselves).
- iv. On successful completion of their five years/four years of stay the graduates need to learn the process of receiving degrees through convocation and reaffirm their commitment to serve the community under oath and practice their profession observing medical ethics in letter and spirit. (To be funded by the College Admn).
- b. Extra-Curricular Activities: The extra-curricular activities are given in the form of a chart on the next page.

b. Extra-Curricular Activities

For the extra-curricular activities the time of the year to be held is suggested by the HODs which is then appoved by the Chief Executive/Principal CMH LMC & IOD through the Academic Council.

The budget allocation for the activity is sanctioned by the Chief Executive/Principal after discussion with the concerned HOD/Staff Member under taking the activity. the extra-curricular activities are held usually in the month of March. Each year the expeted amount to run these activities is five to six millions subject to inflation.
