

**SOP - CODE OF CONDUCT**  
**SOCIAL, MORAL, ETHICS, RELIGIOUS, AND PERFORMING ARTS POLICY**

**Introduction**

1. The CMH LMC & IOD recognizes the importance of maintaining a conducive and respectful environment for all students. This Student Code of Conduct outlines for social, moral, ethical, religious, and performing arts-related activity guidelines to ensure a harmonious atmosphere within the college community.

**2. Social Conduct**

- a. Students are expected to treat each other with respect, courtesy, and empathy.
- b. No student shall engage in any form of harassment, bullying, or discrimination based on race, gender, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, or any other characteristic.
- c. Respect for personal space and boundaries is essential; physical contact should be consensual and appropriate.
- d. Intimate physical expressions of affection (hugging, holding hands, kissing & embracing) are not permitted in this college premises, in college bus or in any outdoor activity like hospital, wards, field trips and college events.
- e. Two college students from opposite or same gender are Not allowed to sit in classroom before or after the class. Students are Not allowed to sit as couple in college stairs, patio, library outside the auditorium and in hideouts. Security cameras are recoding all activities.

**3. Moral and Ethical Standards**

- a. Students are expected to uphold high moral and ethical standards both within and outside the college premises.
- b. Integrity and honesty are fundamental values to be maintained in all Curricular and Co-Curricular pursuits.
- c. Plagiarism, cheating, and other forms of academic dishonesty are strictly prohibited during exams or competitions.

**4. Religious Practices**

- a. The college acknowledges and respects the diversity of religious beliefs among its students.
- b. Students are free to practice their religion, but any religious activities should not disrupt the academic or social environment.

**5. Performing Arts Policy**

- a. Demonstrations, performances, or displays that may be objectionable to any member of the college community are not allowed.
- b. Any performing arts event organized within the college premises should adhere to the guidelines set by the college administration.

- c. No performance shall include vulgar language, obscenity, or content that may be offensive to any religious or cultural group.
- d. Stage performance of Girls like dance, bhangra Ludi, etc single or in groups in Not allowed in college.
- e. Any play, drama or performance will be vetted by ethical / character building committee before performance.

6. **Attire Guidelines**

- a. Students are expected to dressup in a manner that is respectful and in adherence to the cultural norms of the college.
- b. Wearing clothing that is excessively revealing or offensive is not permitted.
- c. Cross-dressing or wearing attire traditionally associated with the opposite gender is discouraged to maintain a professional and respectful environment.

7. **Consequences for Violations**

- a. By adhering to this Student Code of Conduct, students contribute in creating a positive and inclusive learning environment at CMH LMC & IOD.
- b. Any violation of this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action, including warnings, probation, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity of the infraction.
- c. The college reserves the right to take appropriate action based on the nature and impact of the violation.
