



# GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TEST

1. Every applicant has to be registered through the online admission portal for School of Allied Health Sciences (SAHS) Admission Test.
2. Candidates shall be admitted to the examination halls after proper identification. Candidates must bring along original Registration Fee deposit Slip OR Proof of Online Payment, original CNIC, copy of the email received and Admit Card to appear in the Admission Test at campus.
3. Candidates must arrive at the Examination Hall / Room **One Hour** before the start of test.
4. Be seated as per seating plan depicted at the entrance of hall / Room. Candidates cannot enter after first half of the examination time. Candidate cannot leave the exam hall during first fifty minutes and in the last twenty minutes of examination.
5. The paper is of 100 marks. Division of subjects as follows;

6. The Exam comprises one (1) question paper.
7. The question paper consists solely of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs). These are 4 Options MCQs (A, B, C, D) with One Best Answer only.
8. There are 100 MCQs in the paper. The questions are based on Matric and F. Sc Curricula.
9. The duration of the paper is 100 Minutes. The paper will start at 10:00 AM and end at 11:40 AM.
10. There will be no negative marking. All questions are compulsory and carry equal marks.
11. OMR Sheets can only be filled with blue or black ball point. Lead Pencil or Ink Pen are not Allowed. Answers are to be noted by filling the bubbles on the OMR sheets against the question numbers.
12. Please make sure you fill the OMR Sheet properly as per instructions of the superintendent and invigilation staff so that your time and effort does not get wasted.
13. Using any unfair means to gain unfair and undue advantage shall be dealt with strictly resulting in cancellation of the paper and your permanent disqualification.
14. Once in the examination hall, do as instructed. Failure to comply may result in cancellation of your paper.

15. Do not bring any books, notes or other belongings to the hall. There is no place to store them. Administration shall not be responsible for loss of property/ belongings.
16. Calculators, Mobile Phone and Other electronic devices are not allowed inside and outside the Examination Hall.
17. Bring your own stationery. The containing box or pouch must be transparent. If you bring your own clipboard, that too must be transparent. Borrowing at the place of examination is not permitted.
18. Candidates once inside the Examination Hall/ Rooms will not be permitted to proceed to washrooms / toilets or any other place outside the Examination Halls / Rooms.
19. All rough work is to be done on the right side of question paper, opposite the same question. Calculators are not allowed.
20. Pin-drop silence is to be maintained during the entire duration of examination.
21. Please fill in only the three digits roll number from your admit card in the appropriate columns in the OMR sheet starting from the left.
22. Further instructions shall be given before the examination and also posted outside the examination halls.
