About the College



CMH Lahore Medical College was established in the year 2006. It is located near the premises of Combined Military Hospital Lahore in the secure and serene environment of Lahore Cantonment. The College occupies a total area of about 12 acres. Initially affiliated with University of Health Sciences (UHS) & later affiliated with National University of Medical Sciences (NUMS) in 2015.

Inauguration of the New Campus was held on 16 January 2010 by the Prime Minister of Pakistan. The new campus is a purpose built building, which is one of the most beautiful structures in the metropolitan city. It is a fine blend of architecture, accessibility and comfort.

The campus consists of well-equipped and state-of-art lecture rooms for each department, Anatomy dissection hall, tutorial rooms. Laboratories, Library, Computer Lab, Skills Lab, Phantom Head lab, a grand Auditorium, cafeteria, book shop, sports complex and a spacious parking area. This college is amongst top Medical Colleges of Pakistan who have been registered by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) in A+ category.

CMH LMC & IOD impart training in MBBS, BDS, SAHS and ION. In SAHS 5 years Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) and 4 years Medical Imaging Technology (MIT) programs offered. Three new programs of BSc (Hons) Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT), BSc (Hons) Human Nutrition & Dietetics and BSc (Hons) Optometry are being started from 2025. ION has also started self-finance seats BS Nursing from 2025 in this institute.

Code of Conduct

All students are advised to read the rules carefully and abide by these rules as envisaged in the prospectus, college notification and their modifications as and when issued. Violations of these rules tantamount to breach of college discipline. The case will be investigated by senior members of the staff and will be forwarded to the college Disciplinary Committee for further investigation and its recommendations will be forwarded to the Principal for further necessary action.

General Rules

- The students must wear their identification cards on a lanyard at all times while in the college premises and hospital.
- All students must maintain the decorum of the college through decent and respectable behavior.
- Students are forbidden to sing, whistle, hoot, create noise, use abusive language, fight and indulge in any unseemly behavior, politics or activity in the college premises at any time.
- No student is allowed to loiter and move aimlessly in and around college premises or waste his / her time in college cafeteria extensively.
- Students have to be present in time, at any specified activity of the college.
- Student's notices / messages will only be displayed on the notice board placed by the college authorities with the approval of the Principal.

Moral and Ethics

The students must essentially display the highest moral and ethical standards at the college, hospital and hostels with conduct par excellence.

College and Government Property

The care and safety of all the property used by students will be ensured by themselves by preventing any willful damage, loss or theft. All damages in any form caused by the students due to their negligence or deliberate act shall be repaired at the expense of the student responsible for the negligence. Walls, fixtures, furniture, models, specimens, charts, skeletal bones, audiovisual teaching aids, notice boards etc. shall not be defaced, mutilated or damaged in any way or form.

Student Attendance

- Each student is expected to attain 100% attendance. However, a minimum attendance of 75 % is MANDATORY "individually" in each subject being taught (in that year in lectures, practicals, tutorials, SGD, CBL, PBL, demonstration and clinical wards), in order to qualify for appearing in NUMS professional exam.
- The margin of 25% of absence is only on account of sickness or any emergency if considered justifiable by the CE / Principal. Repeated absence from lectures, practicals, tutorials, demonstration and clinical wards without any justified reasons will make a student liable for punishment. The students must periodically check their attendance record form concerned department. For leave, the student must apply their leave on student's leave portal. The reasons for leave should be clearly mentioned. Leave taken will be at the students own risk as far as the percentage of attendance is concerned, even the medical certificate will not condone for any deficiency in attendance.



Academic Performance Assessment

Attaining of 50% marks individually in each subject in Class tests / Module test / Mid term / Final term / Pre-Annual examination is MANDATORY. A student can be dropped from appearing in University Exam by the Principal on account of poor academic performance.

Class/ Ward Discipline

Teachers and students maintain a highly professional interaction in the academic sessions which is a very distinct feature of the college, and the same has to be continued at all times. Students must **switch off their cell phones before they enter the lecture room, laboratory and wards**. Punctuality regarding class/ ward timings and maintenance of proper discipline in the classrooms, practicals, demonstrations, tutorials and ward is mandatory.

Peaceful Environment

The maintenance of a safe and secure environment in the campus, hospital and hostels has immense importance in a professional institute. The college accords the highest priority to this vital aspect.



SOP

Disciplinary Committee – CMH LMC & IOD

1. The College Disciplinary Committee keeps effective watch over maintenance of discipline and enforces the code of conduct in routine daily matters. A team nominated by Principal, will comprise the committee. In cases of any breach of discipline, the decision taken by the Principal will be final and can't be challenged. The committee will meet on quarterly / required basis.
2. **Composition of the committee will be as under:-**
 - a. **President:- Dy Chief Executive / Vice Principal**
 - b. **Members:-**
 - (1) **Vice Principal (Academics)**
 - (2) **Dean IOD**
 - (3) **HoD Pathology**
 - (4) **HoD Behavioral Sciences**
 - (5) **HoD Medicine**
 - (6) **HoD Physiology**
 - (7) **AD (Student Affairs)**
3. **Proceedings**
 - a. Notice shall be served to the accused, with evidence of breach of code of conduct when applicable.
 - b. The accused shall be provided an opportunity to respond in writing against the allegations with any evidence to support his / her claims.
 - c. The accused shall be provided with an opportunity of personal hearing by the committee.
 - d. The decision of the committee shall be communicated in writing.
 - e. There shall be an opportunity for appeal against decision to the Principal which can be availed once only.
 - f. Decision on appeal by the Principal shall be **Final**.
4. **Punishments**

Various punishments may be awarded by the committee according to the nature and degree of violation of rules by the students will be as under:-

 - a. Withdrawal from college rolls.
 - b. Debarment from all academic activities.
 - c. Cancellation of hostel allotment.
 - d. Cancellation of leave.
 - e. Cash fines.
 - f. Extra library sittings.
 - g. Ban to visit cafeteria and hostel.
 - h. Formal warning with information to parents / guardian.
 - j. Disallowing to apply for university examination.
 - k. Other disciplinary action as deemed necessary.



5. The recommendation of committee will be put up to Chief Executive / Principal for final approval.

6. Grievance Policy / Appeals

The accused who has been awarded any penalty by the disciplinary committee may prefer and apply for appeal or review to the Chief Executive / Principal.

- a. An appeal review shall be made in the form of a petition and in writing.
- b. The appeal shall be filed with the authority who passed the original orders.
- c. The appeal/review petition shall be made within seven days from promulgation of punishment awarded.
- d. The petition shall set forth concisely the ground of objection to the punishment awarded in a proper and template language (shall not contain dis-respectful or obscene language)
- e. The accused at no stage of the proceeding shall be represented by an advocate / counsel.
- f. The decision of the Authority shall be final and can not be challenged in any court of law.



Infirmary

ADMISSION CRITERIA - MBBS & BDS SESSION 2024-2025

The Criteria for Merit formulation and admission is as under, this all will be routed through NUMS.

► Weightage Formula

F.Sc. Pre-Medical/HSSC/Equivalence	40%
Matric/SSC/Equivalence	10%

► Eligibility

- Passing NUMS MDCAT with 55% marks for MBBS & 50% for BDS shall be mandatory for admission.
- Must have obtained an HSSC/FSc Pre-Medical or an equivalent 12th-grade qualification recognized in Pakistan having obtained more than sixty percent (60%) marks therein, or a higher percentage as may be notified by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC)

Confirmation of Admission

Admission of the selected students will only be confirmed after they have deposited the college admission, tuition and other fees as prescribed within specific days along with required documents. If admission is not confirmed within the stipulated fee deposit time frame, the seat is offered to the next candidate on the merit list. Once a student is admitted in the college and if his/her documents are found incorrect, admission will be cancelled and the fees/dues are forfeited.

SAHS was established in 2018 with a Pioneer batch of DPT and MID. DPT is a 5-year program whereas MID is a 4-year study program. SAHS was initially affiliated with University of Lahore and in 2020 affiliation was shifted to UHS. First Convocation of SAHS was conducted in Nov 2024. 83 x graduates of DPT and 86 x graduates in MID were awarded degrees & medals by VC UOL. 1. Eligibility

a. Must have obtained an HSSC / FSc Pre - Medical or an equivalent 12th-grade qualification recognized in Pakistan having obtained more than sixty percent (60%) marks therein, for admission in DPT and fifty percent (50%) marks for MIT or a higher percentage as may be notified by UHS.

b. Passing the MCQs based Aptitude Test is mandatory for admission which will be conducted by Institutional Examination Cell (IEC) (modalities of conduct of test will be finalized by IEC)

Institute of Nursing CMH Lahore Medical College & IOD

The institute of Nursing was located in CMH Lahore previously, and was shifted to CMH LMC & IOD in 2012. BSN 4 Years program was started in 2014 and one year midwifery course is also running in this institution.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing is 4-years program and aims to train graduates to provide safe, competent and compassionate nursing care in a professional manner. The curriculum is based on the concepts of relational practice, leadership, critical nursing care and ethical care. Courses are taught by qualified and experienced faculty. The institute has state of the art skills lab for training of students.
