

Subject: Policy for Detained Students of MBBS & BDS

1. Purpose:

To establish clear guidelines for students who are detained after failing a subject / subjects in supplementary university examination, ensuring they meet academic and attendance standards to qualify for next university annual professional examination.

2. Policy Details:

- a) **Re-enrollment as Fresh Student:** Students detained in any subject / subjects after supplementary examination will be required to re-enroll as fresh students for the subject / subjects in the subsequent academic year.
- b) **Attendance Requirement:** Detained students must achieve a minimum attendance of 75% from academic year 2026 - 2027 onwards, in all academic sessions (i.e. lectures, practicals, tutorials, SGDs and clinical sessions, etc.) related to subject / subjects of detention during re-enrolled year.
- c) **Internal Assessment:** Students are required to pass minimum 60% of assessments, including class tests, block exams and send up examination, in the subject / subjects they are repeating.


3. Eligibility for Annual Professional Examination:


Only student who meets both attendance and internal assessment criteria (applicable as above), will be eligible to appear in the next annual professional examination for the subject / subjects in which he / she was previously detained.


